About the Special Program ...

We join SAE Detroit/Toledo Section for a tour of the world's largest Corvette collection at ProTeam Classic Corvette Collection & Sales in Napoleon, Ohio on **Thursday, May 13, 2004**. Larry Wilson from GM will speak about designing the new C6 Corvette. **Two tour sessions** of 20 participants each will be available **at 4:00 p.m. and at 4:30 p.m.** After the tour, additional networking and dinner (on your own) will be available at the Mexican restaurant *El Mexico Escondido* at the Quality Inn a mile north on Route 108.

ProTeam has close to 60,000 sq. ft. of buildings (five showrooms and a body shop) housing over 150 Corvettes. Most of these buildings were acquired and/or built in 1987 through 1996. ProTeam's inventory normally consists of 40-45 1954 to 1962's; 60-70 1963 to 1967's; and 30-40 1968 to 1982 vintage Corvettes.

ProTeam (www.proteam-corvette.com) is located on Route 108, south of Route 6/Route 24 bypass. ProTeam is 13 miles south of I-80 (Ohio Turnpike) at Exit 3/34. ProTeam is 25 minutes from Toledo, OH; 1 ½ hours from Detroit, MI and 50 minutes from Ft. Wayne or Auburn, IN. 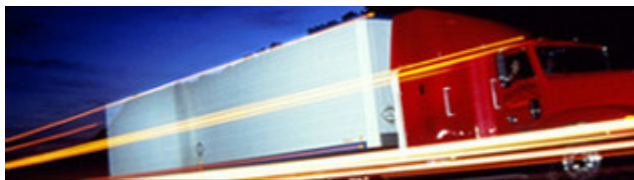
