The **World War II Victory Museum** gives homage to the sacrifices made by the men and women who fought in the Second World War as well as those who contributed on the home front.

The cornerstone of the World War II Victory Museum's collections is its vehicle collection (comprised mostly of vehicles from the former Victory Memorial Museum that was located in Belgium). The World War II Victory Museum features more than 150 vehicles that were manufactured in 11 different nations and used by numerous armies in the European and North African theaters of the war. This magnificent collection of vehicles varies in scope from light tanks down to motorcycles and includes many extremely rare pieces and a few unique survivors. To complement the extraordinary vehicle collection, the World War II Victory Museum also has hundreds of uniforms and other artifacts from the war.

The **Kruse Classic Car Museum** is the home of an impressive display of over 100 automobiles and carriages. Inside the museum you can find racecars, customized hot rods, TV and movie cars, carriages and coaches, and very classic cars such as Auburns, Cords, and Duesenbergs.

The museum has also been blessed with the friendship of the legendary Carl Casper. A substantial portion of Mr. Casper's collection is currently housed in the museum, including the Vanturian, one of the Batmobiles from Batman Returns, and the royal coronation coach of King Ernst August of Hannover (1837-1851).

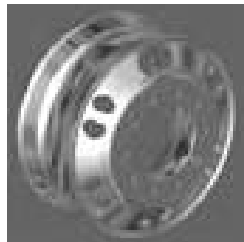

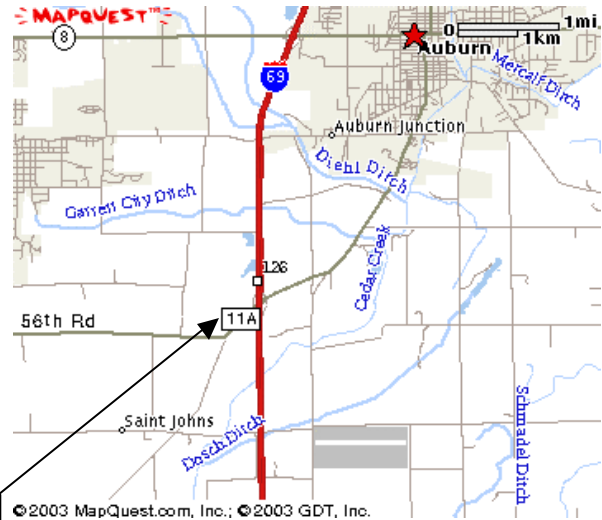
