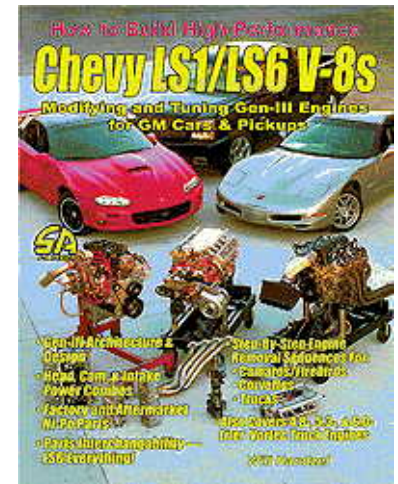

About the Program and Speaker ...

In 1997, Chevrolet did the unthinkable: they introduced a completely re-designed version of the most modified engine in American history—the small block Chevy V-8. To the aftermarket performance community, this redesign has initiated dramatic changes. While the original small-block V-8 made its debut in 1955, the aftermarket is still developing most of its performance components for this older architecture. As more people in the aftermarket business discover the superior design and quality of the Gen III V-8, they are creating and offering products and services for this 'new' engine. Handzel, author of the just-released book 'How to Build High-Performance Chevy LS1/LS6 V-8s', will continue that 'discovery' process as he discusses the behind-the-scenes creation of the Gen III V-8 and what production parts are good for performance applications. He'll also talk about where the aftermarket can make power gains with the Gen III, and the latest iteration of the small block, the Gen IV V-8.

Our Speaker is Will Handzel, Technical Content Manager, GM Performance Division, General Motors.

Will Handzel is a former staffer of Circle Track, Rod & Custom, and HOT ROD magazines who has worked at GM for the last 5 years. About 3 years ago, he embarked on a journey in his 'spare time' to create the definitive shop-staple book on the Gen III LS1 V-8. The result is a book that covers everything from the Gen III history to technical details and part numbers on GM components and assembly methods. There are also dyno tests of Gen IIIs with aftermarket products along with details on removing/reinstalling the Gen III engine and more.
