For sixteen years, Max E. Rumbaugh, Jr. served as the Executive Vice President and General Manager of the SAE. In his position, he was the convener of the senior engineering executives of the major American automobile companies. In these meetings, Max participated in the early stages of the Program for a New Generation of Vehicles (PNGV). It was this program that spawned renewed international interest in Hybrid Electric and Fuel Cell powered vehicles. He also drove the Toyota Prius in Japan prior to its introduction into the market place.

Max's presentation, **Is There A Hybrid Electric Vehicle in Your Future?** describes the process used to select the hybrid electric as a leading technology for future vehicles and provides a description of its design and functioning. He has prepared this presentation based upon his unique observation post during the development of Hybrid Electric vehicle technology.

A graduate of the US Military Academy (West Point), he subsequently received his Masters degrees in Engineering and in Business from Purdue University.

Max first joined SAE while working for Schwitzer in Indianapolis. He served as the Indiana SAE Section Chair and Regional Advisor while living in Indiana. Max is looking forward to returning to Indiana for this presentation.
